Haydn, Hob. 10/i

- The structural cadences for this piece are as follows:
  - Exposition:
    - m. 4: IAC in C major
    - m. 8: HC in C major
      - After this half-cadence-forming dominant chord, Haydn simply takes off in the dominant key of G major.
    - m. 16: PAC in G major (in octaves)
    - mm. 16-21: closing material with a PAC in m. 21
  - Development:
    - m. 31: HC in A minor (the submediant)
    - m. 38: HC in C major, setting up the recapitulation in m. 39
    - m. 46 is analogous to m. 8. This time, however, the music stays in the tonic key instead of modulating to the dominant.
